CPTED and ISO 22341 and CPTED Training

CPTED has changed due to evidence

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) has changed significantly over the last 10 years.

Now based on evidence rather than speculation, CPTED uses 11 effective principles that include physical, social and environmental tools for crime prevention PLUS standard CPTED processes for the built environment and includes new CPTED documentation.

These major changes to CPTED are captured in the new international standard for CPTED, ISO 22341:2021.

This new international ISO 22341 CPTED standard simplifies much of the documentation of planning, architecture and development application as it enables

certification of CPTED analysis and interventions in planning, design and management of the built environment.

The Design Out Crime and CPTED Centre is providing certified online CPTED Training focusing on using the ISO 22341 CPTED standard. This includes CPTED training certified to Class A standard by the International CPTED Association (ICA). This Class A certified training exempts applicants for ICA certification as Certified CPTED Practitioner or Certified CPTED Professional from completing the onerous record book portfolio otherwise required for submission.

These significant international standards for CPTED are important to statutory planning agencies, urban planners, architects, developers, national and local government planning agencies, police, community safety, security, Neighbourhood Watch and all involved in reducing crime and improving quality of life.
